



Little Las Vegas: Hal's Fabulous Vegas Bar & Grille



Who knew that you could get a little piece of Las Vegas here in Greewood, Indiana. Bust through the double doors of **Hal's Fabulous Vegas Bar & Grille**, and it will feel like you just stepped off the plane. All this show-stopping restaurant needs is a roulette table and a few decks of cards. What they do have at Hal's is an updated menu with new summer items, flashing lights, and sweet, sweet casino decor. Even the bar has padded elbow rests and is marked like a real blackjack table. The bartender is decked out in a flashy vest and deals drinks like a pro. This place has genuine flair that can be traced to the smallest detail.

Chef Keith Angell came out from the kitchen to personally recommend his latest creation, a salmon and bacon rilette served with crostinis and a shot of gazpacho presented in a hollow cucumber cup (pictured below - \$11). I loved this amazing finger food. Just scoop a bit of the rich rilette onto the crispy crostinis, and wash it down with the slightly spicy, yet refreshing chilled soup - a great balance of flavors and textures!

Since the appetizer was quite filling, my dining buddy and I split an entree; the Penne ala Vodka (\$13). This is also another new menu item. I'm so glad they put it on there because it is amazing! The pasta is dredged in a creamy tomato vodka sauce and topped with bacon pieces and Parmesan cheese. The portions were gargantuan and came with a side salad to boot.

Hal's would be a great place to host a party. I need to make up an excuse to do so. Good times are soon to be had at Hal's.
